Conditions for Geocache Placement

- There will be no time limit for placement of a geocache, but it is recommended the cache be monitored by the applicant or a representative at least quarterly. The Property/land manager reserves the right to remove or move the cache if there's a conflict of interest. The Ho-Chunk Nation (Nation) will contact the Applicant if this is to occur.
- The Nation reserves the right to determine if a cache adversely impacts its environments. Caches are never permitted on or near cultural sites sensitive to the Nation, preservation sites registered with the State of Wisconsin or the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).
- The Nation takes no responsibility for any vandalism or other damage to the geocache.
- Cache containers are not to be buried. A geocache is considered buried if mineral soil must be moved to access the geocache. Placing rocks, bark, leave, logs etc. over a cache or placing a geocache into a naturally occurring crevice or hole is not considered burial.
- Geocache owners/placers are required to maintain the cache site. All cache containers shall be hidden from general view. Cache containers designed to be hidden in plain view will need prior approval by the Nation. All virtual cache sites located on Nation Federal Trust lands will need prior approval.
- The following items are not allowed to be stored in or around geocache sites located on Nation properties:
 - * Food/Candy of any kind
 - * Weapons of any kind
 - * Material restricted from minors
 - * Animal attractants
 - * Illegal items.
- Geocache owners/placers are allowed to move the geocache to new locations to avoid volunteer trails developing. Owners/placers must notify the Nation if this occurs. The Nation will request the cache be relocated if volunteer trails begin to occur.
